NOTICE OF RAMP CLOSURE:

Closure of Hwy 417 Eastbound Kent Street Off-Ramp
Re-opening of Hwy 417 Eastbound Bronson Ave Off-Ramp

Distribution Date: September 6, 2023

Kiewit Dufferin Midtown Partnership has been retained by the Ontario Ministry of Transportation to replace the Preston Street, Rochester Street, Booth Street, Bronson Avenue, and Percy Street bridges on Highway 417, the Ottawa Queensway, as well as undertake operational improvements from the O-Train bridges easterly to the Kent Street bridge and noise barrier replacements from Island Park Drive easterly to Kent Street.

To facilitate this work, KDMP will be required to implement traffic control staging on Highway 417 and City streets. It is KDMPs intent to keep an open and upfront communication channel with all residents and affected agencies. To that end, please see the below information providing further details regarding road closures and the affected area.

WHERE: Highway 417 Eastbound Kent Street Off-Ramp (See Detour Below)

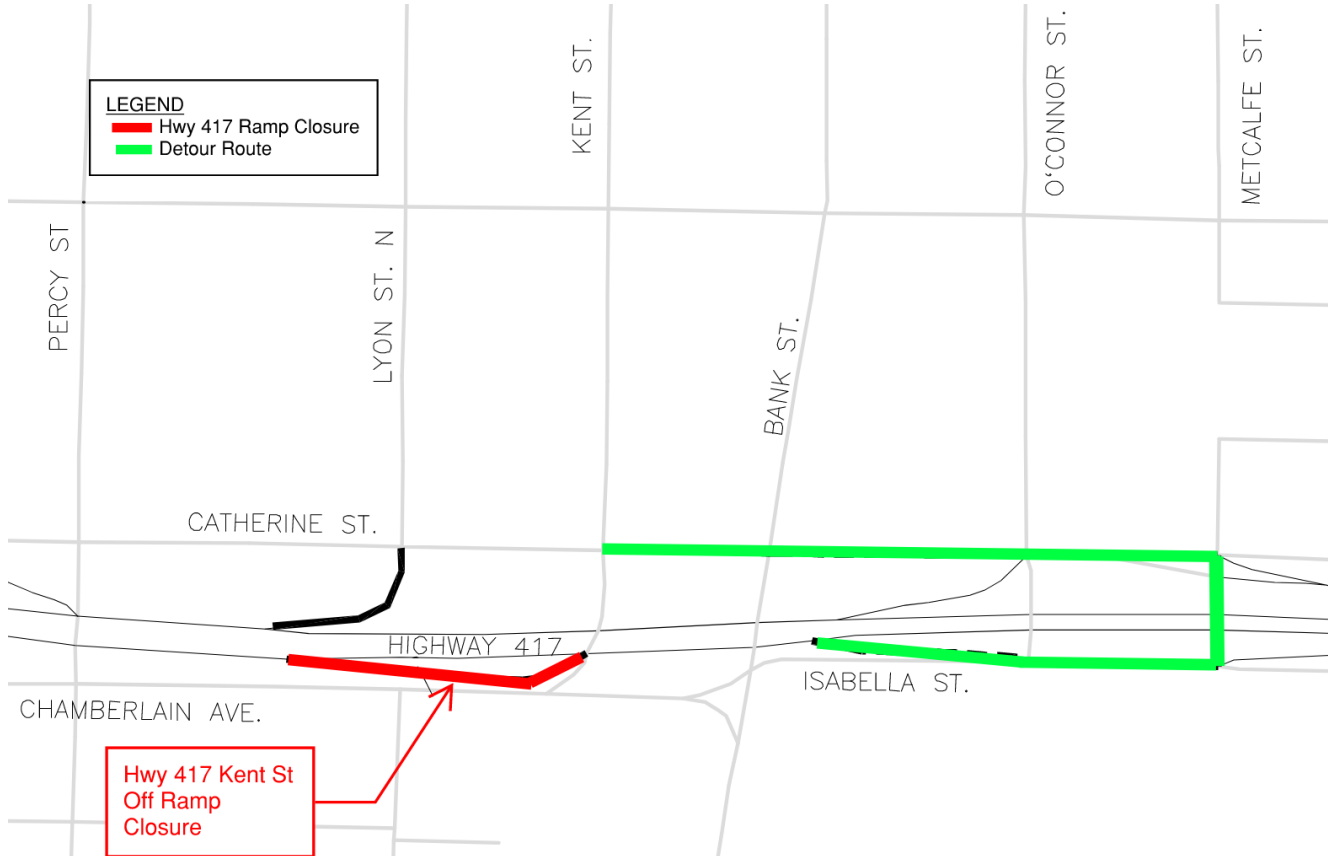
WHEN: Anticipated Start Date: September 15, 2023
Anticipated End Date: December 22, 2023

WHY: To facilitate the access to construction including but not limited to replacement Retaining walls and Noise barrier walls along the Highway 417.

WHAT: The 417 Eastbound Bronson Ave Off-Ramp will be re-opened on September 8, 2023
The 417 Eastbound Kent Street Off-Ramp will be closed September 15, 2023 to accommodate the following work:

- Excavation, Grading, Replace Curb and Gutter, Remove Replace Asphalt Pavement, Remove and Replace Storm Sewer, Remove and Replace Electrical Infrastructure
- Retaining Wall Construction
